



OUT-OF-ZONE RESIDENCY CHECK HOTLINE

In an effort to ensure that only Seminole County students attend Seminole County schools and additionally that in county students attend their correct zoned schools, the Seminole County School Board has established an anonymous hotline for reporting suspected out-of-zone students.

The Seminole County School Board monitors student enrollment to verify that only Seminole County students attend Seminole County public schools and that students comply with attendance zone and/or transfer policies. Due to the high performance of Seminole County Public Schools, significant numbers of non-Seminole County students annually seek to enroll in Seminole County schools. The Out-of-Zone Residency Check Hotline, 407-320-ZONE (9663), is the most recent addition to the district's on-going efforts to ensure Seminole County Public Schools are populated by Seminole County residents who live in the school zone or who have received a Board-approved transfer. It is intended also to help ensure that students residing within the county are attending their correct zoned school.

Parents or community members who believe that a student is illegally attending a Seminole County Public School are asked to call 407-320-ZONE (9663) and provide the following information.

Student Name

School Name

Area or address where you believe the student is living

Reason you believe the student is out-of-zone

All information provided will be used to investigate the situation and will be confidential.

Seminole County Public Schools monitors student enrollment throughout the school year. Monitoring techniques include looking into suspicious situations reported by school staff, bus drivers, and parents residing in the school zone; investigating why postcards or letters sent to students' homes are returned to the school, checking home telephone numbers to ensure the prefix is not out of the district/school zone; scanning driver's licenses to ensure the address on the driver's license matches the address on the student contact information; and verifying home ownership and homestead exemption status.

Families who relocate are advised to immediately report the new address to their student's school to ensure contact information is updated. Accurate contact information is necessary to address emergency situations and school-related business.
